



7 The wall-coverings at Palazzo Parisio (page 76) and the Casa da Música (page 54) are not cut from the same metallic cloth – the former is a traditional moire similar to Marvic Textiles’s ‘Misa Plain 6565-48’ (£47.50 per m; 020 7352 3119; marvictextiles.co.uk), while the latter is a modern design like Gretchen Bellinger’s ‘All That Glitters 3551-04’ from Alton-Brooke (£156 per m; 020 7376 7008; alton-brooke.co.uk). But the thread that connects them is gold.



8 Rem Koolhaas has composed a symphony of surfaces at the Casa da Música. If you like the wood-grain gilding (page 55), it’ll be music to your ears to hear that French firm Mise En Teinte can do the same, to the tune of £88 approx per sq m. Ring 00 33 1 40 54 06 72.



9 While diners at the Kool restaurant at the Casa da Música (page 48) indulge their oral senses, they can enjoy a feast for the eyes care of the Op-Art-style terrace, which is made from tiles like these black-and-white encaustic ones from Fired Earth (£82.54 per sq m; 01295 814399; firedearth.co.uk).



10 Jasper Morrison’s stool, from Moooi, which appears in the Casa da Música (page 51), and his ‘Cork Family’ stools for Vitra (£226.78 each; 020 7608 6200; vitra.com) are not only made from the same material as humble bottle-stoppers but resemble giant versions.
